this day begins with light pleasant weather
ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward
under all sail at seven A.M. took ship heading
then to the westward saw blackfish this morning
Lat 5-55 S Long 6-40 E
broke out boat and park and better took ship
at six P.M. heading to the southward and eastward

Sunday Dec 15

this day begins with light pleasant weather
ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward
under all sail

Lat 6-20 S Long 7-12 E

nothing in sight to day

this day begins with light pleasant weather
ship steering by the wind heading to the southward and
eastward under all sail at six A.M. saw a small
white water took ship for it saw nothing after
took back again at eight A.M.
