

## Remarks on Board Bark S.B. Hale 1877

Wednesday Jan. 31 Sea time  
 begins with light winds and calm  
 ship steaming by the wind heading to the  
 southeast and westward under all sail at 10 AM the weather wind  
 heeling to the south west ship heading south south east  
 at 1 PM the bark ship heading from east by  
 south to south west later part the same  
 heading the same nothing in sight too day

Thursday Jan. 32  
 begins with pleasant breeze ship  
 steaming by the heading S.W. by W under  
 all sail at 10 AM the bark ship heading  
 then S.E. by S on the starboard tack  
 at 11 AM the bark ship heading then  
 S.W. by W later part the same saw fin back

Friday Jan. 33  
 begins with pleasant breeze ship  
 steaming the same heading S.W. by W  
 saw a whaler to right middle part the same  
 latter part strong breeze ship under top sails  
 steaming the same S.W. by W by the wind  
 water breaking out water

Saturday Jan. 34  
 begins with a fresh breeze  
 ship steaming by the wind heading S.W. by W  
 at 2 AM the bark ship heading by the wind  
 E. by S under top sails middle part the same  
 latter part the same heading the same found a  
 boat in the ships pumps employed repairing it

Sunday Jan. 35  
 begins with strong breeze ship  
 steaming by the wind heading from S to E by S  
 under top sails and reversed middle part  
 the same latter part bark ship at 8 AM the  
 heading then S.W. under top sails

Monday Jan. 36  
 begins with a fresh breeze  
 ship steaming by the wind heading S.W.  
 under top sails at 5 AM the bark ship  
 heading then E. S. E. by the wind on the  
 starboard tack middle part wind the same  
 at 12 AM the bark ship heading S.W. by the wind  
 latter part the same wind and a pleasant breeze  
 broke out beef and setting by the four and main royal  
 bark stays

Lat 14-60 S  
 Long 6-51 E

Tuesday Jan. 37  
 begins with a pleasant breeze ship steaming  
 by the wind heading S.W. under all sail at 3 AM the  
 bark ship heading then E. S. E. by the wind  
 middle part wind freshening latter part ship under  
 top sails at 6 AM the bark ship heading then S.W.  
 water sweeping and painting the iron work

by the day  
 Lat 14-41 S  
 Long 6-22 E

Wednesday Jan. 38  
 begins with a fresh breeze ship steaming  
 by the wind heading S.W. by W under top sails  
 at 1 AM the bark ship heading S.E. by E  
 middle part the same at 12 AM the bark ship  
 heading then S.W. latter part wind lighter ship  
 under all sail two ships in sight at dusk light  
 at seven AM the bark ship heading then E. S. E.  
 by the wind

Lat 14-30 S  
 Long 6-53 E

Thursday Jan. 39  
 begins with light pleasant at 12 AM the  
 bark ship and run of for the bark Tropic Bird  
 spoke her at 4 AM the bark arrived until 4 AM the  
 bark ship and stood to the eastward middle part  
 the same heading the same latter part wind lighter  
 at 9 AM the bark ship heading S.W. by S  
 by the wind
