Thursday Feb 13

Begins with a pleasant breeze ship by the wind on the starboard tack under all sail at sun set took in the light sail
middle part breeze the same ship heading the same
latter part strong breeze ship under short sail for top sail and headed the same broke out water

Friday Feb 14

Begins with fresh breeze ship by the wind on the starboard tack heading to the eastward under top sails masts jib and spanker made new man ropes
middle part ship under short sail at 12 O'Clock m wore ship headed S.W. On the port tack
latter part strong breeze ship under top sails and crosses and headed the same broke out boat

Begins with a strong breeze ship by the wind on the port tack at 5 O'Clock P.M. took ship passed a schooner under our lee going to the south
middle part ship under short sail at 3 O'Clock A.M. wore ship and stood to the westward
latter part strong breeze and squally weather ship by the wind heading the same under short sail for top sail

Begins with strong breeze ship by the wind on the port tack at One O'Clock P.M. raised a sail ahead at 3 O'Clock P.M. spoke and gained Bark Destanyma also saw another whaler

latter part breeze the same ship under top sails

latter part pleasant breeze at 10 O'Clock took ship headed to the westward broke out floor

Begins with a pleasant breeze ship by the wind on the port tack under easy sail at five O'Clock P.M. raised three ships ahead at 6 O'Clock P.M. spoke and gained the George & Mary and Mary Prager five whalers in sight to day
middle part breeze the same ship under short sail
latter part pleasant breeze ship heading the same under all sail but gaff top sail & fore gaff sail watch repairing the job

Begins with a fresh breeze ship by the wind on the port tack under easy sail
middle part breeze the same at 11 O'Clock A.M. wore ship and stood to the eastward ship under short sail
latter part pleasant breeze heading the same watch repairing the fore sail

Begins with a fresh breeze ship by the wind on the starboard tack heading to the eastward
middle part breeze the same ship under short sail at 1 O'Clock A.M. wore ship and stood to the westward
latter part light baffling wind ship under all sail at 11 O'Clock A.M. wore ship and stood to the eastward watch repairing the main sail
