

Remarks on Board Bark S. B. Hall

Friday Feb 21

begin with light pleasant breeze ship by the wind headed to the eastward water off bent the main sail middle part ship under short sail at 3 00 A.M. were ship and stood to the westward latter part pleasant breeze ship under top sails at 8 00 A.M. kept off and stood north west water at work setting up the fore stay

Saturday Feb 22

begin with a pleasant breeze ship steering N.W. under main and sail water off bent the main sail middle part ship under short sail by the wind on the port tack at 11 00 P.M. were ship and stood to the eastward latter part strong breeze ship under top sails at 7 00 A.M. were ship and steamed W. off at 12 00 M. left to the wind on the port tack heading to the westward broke out water.

Sunday Feb 23

begin with a strong breeze ship by the wind heading to the westward under easy sail at sun set stood in sail and were ship stood to the eastward middle part ship under short sail heading the same latter part ship under easy sail heads the same

Monday Feb 24

begin with a stiff breeze ship by the wind and heads to the eastward under easy sail M. 22nd part ship under short sail and heads the same latter part at 8 00 A.M. tacked ship and stood to the westward ship under easy sail saw a humpback

begin with a strong breeze and squally weather ship by the wind heading to the westward under easy sail middle part wind the same at 2 00 A.M. were ship and stood to the eastward latter part strong breeze and thick foggy weather ship by the wind and heads the same under double reefed fore top sail

Thursday Feb 27

begin with strong breeze and thick foggy weather ship by the wind heading to the eastward middle part ship under short sail at 12 M. were ship and stood to the westward latter part at daylight were ship and stood to the eastward ship under easy sail at 8 00 A.M. raised a sail off the sea began at 10 00 A.M. kept off and at 11 1/2 00 A.M. spoke and gained Bark Wanderer

Friday Feb 28

begin with a fresh breeze ship steering N.W. by W. under easy sail at 3 00 P.M. left to the wind on the port tack middle part wind the same ship heads the same latter part ship under easy sail at 8 00 A.M. kept off and stood N.W.
