Saturday Mar 1  
 Steaming N W under main sail at 2 P.M. the  
 changed the course to N at sunset took in sail  
 and left to the wind. On the starboard pack  
 middle part ship under short sail at 12 P.M. were ship  
 and stood to the westward  
 Latter part ship under easy sail at 4 P.M. were ship  
 and stood N N E at 12 P.M.  
 left to the wind heading to the eastward  
 carpenter repairing the over head boat

Sunday Mar 2  
 Lat 15-00 S  
 Long 35 E  
 begins with a pleasant breeze ship by  
 the wind heading to the eastward passed the Gork Wanderer  
 to the windward. Both out boat and pack  
 middle part ship under short sail heading the same  
 at 1 P.M. were ship and stood to the westward  
 Latter part ship under easy sail at 10 P.M. were ship  
 a ship to the windward whaling tack ship and started  
 for him at 12 P.M. raised the whale that she was  
 carrying having four boats down. then we lowered four  
 boats expecting there would be a chance for or but  
 the wanderer boats struck soon after we lowered

Monday Mar 3

 all four boats down for sperm whales saw the  
 bark wanderer boats strike and kill a small  
 whale at 2 P.M. all boats came a board, braced  
 forward and stood by the wind to the westward  
 under all sail  
 middle part strong breeze ship under short sail  
 heading the same at 10 P.M. were ship and  
 stood to the eastward  
 Latter part wind the same ship under easy sail  
 heading the same carpenter repairing the over head  
 boat out water

 begins with a strong breeze ship by the  
 wind heading to the eastward under easy sail at 3 P.M.  
 tacked ship and stood to the westward carpenter at work  
 repairing the over head boat  
 middle part ship under short sail wind the same at 1 P.M.  
 were ship and stood to the eastward  
 Latter part breeze the same at 4 P.M. tacked  
 ship and stood to the westward at 11 P.M. were ship  
 run off and started N W

Wednesday Mar 5  
 Lat 14-58 S  
 Long 36 E  
 begins with a strong breeze ship  
 Steaming N W under main sail carpenter  
 at work on the over head boat  
 middle part ship under short sail heading to the eastward  
 at 10 P.M. were ship and stood to the westward  
 Latter part at 6 P.M. were ship and stood to  
 eastward under easy sail strong breeze at 11 1/2 P.M. were ship  
 sperm whales not raised by the mate on the weather  
 quarter running to the leeward  
 Thursday Mar 6  
 Lat 14-00 S  
 Long 36 E  
 begins with a strong breeze ship

here to laying for a sperm whale at 12 P.M.  
 whale broke water about to the ship. lowered starboard  
 boat shortly after lowered the other three boats  
 whale killed to the forward egg and chased him  
 off at 3 1/2 P.M. west boat struck him and got stuck  
 starboard boat fastened then the whale started  
 to the windward and continued going to the windward  
 and rounding hoary at 5 P.M. took the starboard  
 boats line show no chance to kill him whatever  
 captain having sent his line on to the second water  
 soon after striking hung on to him until 8 P.M.  
 they thought it best to get and did so came aboard  
 after about days work lost two lines and  
 a boat stove and no whale that is enough today  
 middle part strong breeze ship under all sail  
 heading to the westward were ship at 12 P.M.  
 Latter part breeze the same took in the west boat  
 to repair her water rousting. the line on and 400 yds  
 other duties at 10 1/2 P.M. hoisted 5 ship off the  
 lay low and at 11 P.M. found her to be whaling  
 started for her
