

Remarks On Board Bark S. B. Hall

Friday Mar 7

begins with a pleasant breeze ship
under all sail steaming for a vessel whaling to the
seaward at 100 P.M. toward the two greater boats
got down where the whale was which was dead then
and they noting the iron post which made us think
that it was the whale we had been fast to we having
three iron in him one iron remaining after they
hauled him along side which captain Hayes
refused to allow us to get out having not two out
before taking him along side early aboard at
8 P.M. were ship and stood to the westward wind light
middle part wind the same at 11 P.M. were ship
and stood to the eastward ship under short sail
latter part strong breeze ship under easy sail
carpenter repairing the west boat part the B. to W.
cutting

begins with a pleasant breeze ship by
the wind heading to the eastward under easy sail
carpenter at work on the west boat
middle part ship under short sail at 10 A.M.
were ship and stood to the westward
latter part pleasant breeze ship by the wind
heading the same carpenter repairing the west boat
part the Bark Wanderer

begins with a pleasant breeze ship by
the wind heading to the westward but the west
boat out at 100 P.M. and were ship and stood to
the eastward
middle part ship under short sail at 10 A.M.
were ship and stood to the westward
latter part strong winds ship under easy sail
heading the same

Monday Mar 10

begins the same ship on the port
tack heading to the westward at 100 P.M. were ship
and stood to the eastward at sunset took in sail
and were ship
middle part ship under short sail heading the same
latter part ship under easy sail and headed the same
broke out water weather thick

Tuesday Mar 11

begins with a fresh breeze weather
very thick at 100 P.M. raised a ship to the
leeward laying aback kept off and steamed for
her at 4 P.M. spoke one named the B. B. mass
saw a steamer to the windward
middle part ship under short sail heading to the
westward breeze light
latter part ship under all sail except fore top sail
braced the same at 10 P.M. topped ship and
stood to the eastward broke out thick

Wednesday Mar 12

begins with a pleasant breeze
ship by the wind on the eastern tack
middle part ship under short sail heading the same
latter part at 6 P.M. were ship and stood on
the western tack under all sail water repairing
the four top mast staysail

Thursday Mar 13

begins with a pleasant breeze ship
by the wind heading to the westward under all sail
part the B. to mass at sunset took in the
light sail and were ship and stood to the eastward
middle part ship under short sail at 2 P.M.
were ship and stood to the westward
latter part ship under all sail at 6-30 were ship
and stood to the eastward
