Friday Mar 14
 begins with a pleasant breeze
 ship by the wind heading to the eastward under
 all sail
 middle part wind the same ship under short sail
 at 11 A.M. wore ship and stood to the westward
 latter part ship under all sail heading the same
 at 10 A.M. wore ship and stood to the
 eastward repairing the over head boat

Saturday Mar 15
 begins with a fresh breeze ship
 by the wind heading to the eastward under all sail
 middle part ship under short sail heading the same
 at 10 A.M. wore ship and stood to the westward
 latter part strong breeze ship under easy sail
 heading the same repairing the over head boat

Sunday Mar 16
 begins with a fresh breeze ship
 by the wind heading to the westward under
 easy sail at sunset took in the light sail wore
 middle part ship under short sail on the eastern
 tack at 12 M wore ship and stood to the westward
 latter part fresh breeze ship under easy sail heading
 the same at 12 M wore ship and stood on it

Monday Mar 17
 begins with a fresh breeze ship steering
 the same at 12:30 P.M. changed the course to
 N. N. E. at 5 P.M. raised a ship off our
 harbor sailing steered for her at 7 P.M. took in
 sail and left to the wind on the western tack
 middle part ship under short sail heading the same
 at 12 A.M. wore ship and stood on the eastern tack
 latter part ship under easy sail heading the
 same at 8 A.M. a sperm whale was raised
 by a whaler from the harbor of our harbor
 at 4:30 A.M. all four boats got out each
 to the S. B. W. B. and S. B. B. starboard boat
 struck one and the iron dred got stuck by
 the S. B. B. running in to her

Tuesday Mar 18
 begins the same at 12 M took the S. B. B.
 whale along side at 1 P.M. took the S. B. whale
 and at 2 P.M. took the S. B. whale got dinner
 and arranged getting at 3 P.M. a sperm whale
 on board and stood a few minutes out two whales
 in good hooked down for the night
 middle part wind strong and slightly watch employed
 riding at the blower at sunset all hands
 latter part at 6 A.M. took on to the third
 whale and at 7:30 finished riding got breakfast
 and started the works at 10 A.M. wore ship
 and stood to the westward all hands employed clearing
 away the heads

Wednesday Mar 19
 begins the same watch at work clearing
 away the heads broke out reef and work
 middle part wind the same employed boiling
 latter part pleasant breeze ship heading the same employed
 boiling

Thursday Mar 20
 begins with a pleasant breeze ship by the
 wind on the western tack under easy sail
 watch employed boiling at 1 P.M. took in the S. B.
 and wore ship stood on the eastern tack finished
 boiling at 5 P.M.
 middle part ship under short sail heading the same
 latter part ship under all sail except fore top got sail
 with a pleasant breeze watch clearing at 4:30
 a sperm whale the S. B. B. at 10:00 A.M. spoke the
 S. B. B. sea green and stood along on the eastern
 tack broke out flower

Friday Mar 21
 begins the same at 3 P.M. took the ship
 and stood to the westward at 5 P.M. spoke and
 came to a head broke out water
 middle part ship lying aback heading to the
 eastward
 latter part strong breeze ship by the wind
 on the eastern tack at 4 P.M. spoke and
 steamed to the northward and westward several
 different courses through the day
 employed stowing down oil sail repairing the S. B.
 cooper's painting the over head boat
