

Remarks on Board Bark S B Hall

Sunday Mar 30

begins with a fresh breeze ship by the wind on the eastern tack under easy sail about the noon fore to sail this afternoon middle part ship under full sail and masts heading the same at 11 O'Clock P.M. tacked ship and stood to the westward at 12 M. tacked back again. Latter part at 5-30 A.M. tacked ship and stood to the westward

Lat 14-31 S

Monday Mar 31

begins with a fresh breeze ship by the wind on the western tack under easy sail middle part ship under short sail heading the same at 12 O'Clock M. wore ship and stood to the eastward latter part strong breeze ship under easy sail heading the same passed two ships to the leeward

Lat 14-46 S

Tuesday Apr 1

begins the same wind latter towards right at 2-30 O'Clock P.M. tacked ship and stood to the westward middle part ship under short sail heading the same at 12 O'Clock M. wore ship and stood to the eastward latter part pleasant breeze ship heading the same at 6-30 O'Clock P.M. tacked ship and stood to the western tack at 8 O'Clock P.M. tacked off and steamed W by S broke out water

Lat 15-02 S

Wednesday Apr 2

begins with a pleasant breeze ship steering W by S under all sail at 2-30 O'Clock P.M. wore ship and stood by the wind on the eastern tack and at 5-00 spoke and secured B. L. O'Clock middle part ship under easy sail heading the same latter part ship under all sail with a pleasant breeze heading the same broke out sea

Lat 14-12 S

Long 1-12 E

at S. Sherman Master

Thursday Apr 3

begins with a pleasant breeze ship by the wind on the eastern tack under all sail at 2-30 O'Clock P.M. tacked ship and stood on the western tack

middle part wind the same ship heading the same under easy sail latter part ship under all sail heading the same

Lat 14-54 S

Friday Apr 4

begins the same ship heading the same middle part ship under easy sail heading the same latter part wind very light ship heading the same under all sail

Lat 16-10 S

Saturday Apr 5

begins with a very light breeze ship by the wind on the western tack under all sail middle part wind the same ship heading the same latter part the same watch washing the ship

Lat 14-20 S

Sunday Apr 6

begins the same at 2-30 O'Clock P.M. left off and steamed W by S watch at work washing the ship middle part light, ship from the southern ship steering the same under all sail latter part the same at 12 O'Clock M. showed the course to N W W

Lat 18-02 S

Monday Apr 7

begins the same ship heading the same middle part at 8 O'Clock P.M. changed the course to N W wind from the S S E and very light regatta hauled up latter part wind the same at 7 O'Clock A.M. changed the course to N N W watch at work washing the ship at 10 O'Clock P.M. in the starboard boat one merchant ship in sight

Lat 14-40 S

Long 2-47 W
