Lat. S. Lon. W. Wed. 15th
 At anchor, the whole of these twenty four hours were fair
 Crew employed scrubbing the outside of schooner

Thurs 16th
 The whole of these twenty four hours were fair
 Crew employed painting & breaking out

Fri. 17th
 Fair weather
 Hauled the schooner farther up the bay, so lay her dry, so we can get at her bottom

Sat. 18th
 Fair weather the whole 24 hours
 Finished cleaning schooner's bottom & painting outside
 Hauled back into deep water

Sun 19th
 Fair weather the whole 24 hours
 Capt & 2^d Mate went hunting capt. shot 4 deer
 Mate & crew went clamming

Mon 20th
 The whole of these twenty four hours were fair
 Capt. & Mate took the boat & went to an island after an iron cooler & some iron from a wreck
 Second mate aloft mending the main sail

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Dec.

Lat. S. Lon. W. Tues. 21st
 The whole of these twenty four hours were fair
 The Mate went after some more old iron

Wed. 22^d
 These twenty four hours were fair
 Commenced hauling the schooner at 9 o'clock A.M.

Thurs 23^d
 These twenty four hours were fair
 Got under way & out to sea
 Mate & second mate went seal hunting on Raza island & got 14 seal

Fri. 24^d
 The first part of these twenty four hours were fair, with a moderate northerly wind. During the night it blew half a gale from the S.W. the latter part more moderate
 Capt. went seal hunting & got 8 making him all
 Took our Dept. Raza island bearing N.W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile

Sat. 25^d
 The whole of these twenty four hours were fair, with a light S.W. wind during the first few hours.
 By 6 P.M. the wind hauled to the northerly & easterly, blowing strong from N.E. the rest of the twenty four hours.
