We had a strong W. wind the 1st part & by night wind hauled to the West

Moderate westerly wind with rain during the 1st part, & fair the rest of the 24 hours

Finished trying out & steaming down 92 lbs. of oil

Sun. 6th

Mon. 7th

These 24 hours were fair with a moderate Westerly wind

Got under way & sailed South

Raised some whales & lowered

the lead, but when we got to them we found them to be Harp seals

Spoke the Argentine cutter in the Strait of Magellan

Tues. 8th

These twenty four hours were fair with a steady breeze during the first part the latter part more moderate

Parted our jet day during the night at dusk repairing it
