The first 9 latter part of these twenty four hours we had a strong S.E. wind. The night was calm

Mon. 21<sup>st</sup>

The wind during these twenty four hours was moderate but continually changing

Tues. 22<sup>nd</sup>

The first part of night we had strong westerly winds with some small, the latter part light winds

We are bound into Galveston for water, came in anchor in mouth of river at 6 P.M.

Wed. 23<sup>rd</sup>

These winds from 6 a.m. were fair with light changing winds  
1 anchor in mouth of river & mending sail

Thur. 24<sup>th</sup>

Fair with strong westerly winds

Weighted anchor to go on the river, and it commenced blowing so hard I started up with a sail that we let go again

Fri. 25<sup>th</sup>

Fair with moderate westerly winds

Started up the river, by tide turning we let go again

Sat. 26<sup>th</sup>

Part fair with light westerly wind night & latter part wind strong & gally

Arr'd the settlement today & upon anchor I got of a raft of water
