Sun 27th

The first part of these twenty four hours were fair with light winds, strong westerly squalls during the night, & latter part light winds again

Mon 28th

These twenty four hours were fair with variable winds

We got another raft of water about mid day

Tues 29th

These twenty four hours were fair with light variable winds

Wed 30th

Fair with light variable winds

Wheeler anchor & drove down to the mouth of the river where we don't anchor & got the Mad cows

Thurs 31st

Fair with light westerly winds. Wheeler anchor & drove out we gained the bk. rocks of Swan with a cargo of sheep from the Faulkner id to Callegos

We anchored near the mouth of Callegos river until morning when we again went into the river, but did not go down

April

Fri 1st

1st part Fair with moderate westerly during the night the wind increased to half a gale with the latter part more moderate

We are at anchor in the river bed & at a second anchor during the night

Sat 2nd

The whole of these twenty four hours were fair with a strong westerly wind

Sun 3rd

Fair with light winds
