Sat. 23rd

Commencing with light shifting
winds & rain a light westerly breeze
during the latter part

Staring N.W. by E.

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Sun. 24th

Commencing with a light west wind
by night the wind hauled to the
south & becoming an strong shortland
sail to double reefed main sail
Fore sail & jib latter wind light slack and
at 11:00 Staring N.W. by E.

Mon. 25th

Commencing with moderate wind
from S.W. Middle & latter part
strong breezes, starting N.W. by E.
carried away but after main sheet
got up wire-rope & secured mast
reduced sail to reef

Tues. 26th

Commencing with a strong wind from
North Middle part wind hailing
to West & steady at N.W. during
latter part

Staring N.W. by E. & E.

Wed. 27th

Commencing squally weather, wind
hailing from N.W. & S.W. & increasing
a cold air running, shipped a heavy
sea on 1st quarter & carried away
starboard mast & stern mast & all
masting gear in them, washed overboard
the whole lot containing all cutting
spades boarding knives baning
knives &c. &c.
