

Sailors Home Honolulu I. I.

1868

Saturday 31st This morning there is a fine breeze from the West & quite a number of ships are of the Harbor waiting to come in they are the Onward & two Dutch ships there are no ships in sight to day I sent two letters home to day

Sunday 1st

November 1st 1868

Several ships have come in to day they will soon be all in now it has been very warm to day I went to meeting at Fort St Church this evening Capt Chisholm was here

Monday 2nd

I have been cruising around the Wharves most all day to day watching the ships come in for came in to day this evening I went to ride with Frank Boye

Tuesday 3rd

This morning it has rained steadily but one ship has come in to day

Wednesday 4th

Very warm to day with light winds from West two ships came in to day

Thursday 5th

Light Breeze to day Solani Josephine Eagle & Ben Cummings came in to day

Friday 6th

This morning light breeze from West Europe came in this morning nine more out sick

Saturday 7th

Steamer Idaho arrived this morning being news of an Earthquake in San Francisco & the U.S. Mail I expected to get a letter from home but was disappointed but disappointments mark our every day life so let it go for as much as it is worth

Sunday 8th

Very warm to day I went to the Bethel this morning and Fort St Church this evening no ships today

Monday 9th

Ship Rainbow arrived here to day from Tahiti to the Od

Tuesday 10th

Barb D C Murry arrived from San Francisco to day U.S. Steamer arrived very warm light southerly winds

Wednesday 11th

Southerly winds to day no ships in sight

Thursday 12th

Winds still to the South and very warm

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Friday 13th Very warm to light southerly winds no ships to day I have been riding this afternoon

Saturday 14th

Steamer Idaho sailed to day carrying the U.S.

Mail

Wind blows South

Sunday 15th

I have been at home all day to day no ships in sight to day southerly winds

Monday 16th

At last we have got the trade winds and now we look for ships any day

Tuesday 17th

DK Sea Breeze arrived to day with news & ship value 200 mile 250

Wednesday 18th

Clipper ship outside the reef Small Box aboard from San Francisco bound to China Light Trades to day

Thursday 19th

Strong trades to day very dry and dusty ship Adair sailed for home to day

Friday 20th

Ship Cornucopia Howland arrived to day I have been to ride out to Diamond Head to day

Saturday 21st

Things are very quiet to day I have been out walking until I got tired so took a nap

Sunday 22nd

Everything is very quiet about town to day light trades

Monday 23rd

I have been to ride this afternoon went up on Punch Bowl Hill strong trades to day

Tuesday 24th

Ship Champion sailed for home to day strong trades and very dusty

Wednesday 25th

Light southerly winds to day and hot and dusty

Thursday 26th

This morning we have the trades again very warm to day

Friday 27th

Fine weather to day and very warm southerly winds this afternoon

Saturday 28th

King's birth day to day

Sunday 29th

Fine weather
