January 1871

Friday 13th

Came in with heavy wind from West at 8 this morning kept off before it. Turning East Set the top Sails close reefed & fore sail at 10 still moderates a little turned two cups out the main top sail & ran with that sail through the day. We have got three sick men. Toward one of them quite bad & have been bleeding him this afternoon his blood was very black & quite thick at first but soon became clear & ran high this is my first experience at bleeding patients & sincerely hope it is the last

Saturday 14th

Lat 48-09

Long 134-01

Came in with light wind from the South & continues so throughout the day I have made two jack stays for the main royal yard to stay and put them on and other small jobs to numerous to mention

Sunday 15th

The day we have had a strong wind from the West with rain ship running before it. Staring East

Monday 16th

Came in with strong wind from West with heavy sea running. Staring by North continues to blow strong throughout the day

Tuesday 17th

Commenced with strong breeze from the West with heavy squalls of rain this afternoon wind freshens. Shorten sail run under double reefs throughout the day

Lat 51-30

Long 115-40

Wednesday 18th

Came in with strong wind from W-S-W with heavy squalls ship under double reefs & courses stiring by North by Compass to sea's variation to East continues about the same

Lat 51-51

Long 111-02

Thursday 19th

Came in with strong wind but with steady set the main top gall sail latter part comes on tremendous heavy squall of snow & hail took in sail & double reefed again

Lat 52-20

Long 106-00

Friday 20th

Came in with strong wind from West with rain & fog & continues so through the day
