Commences with light winds &
good weather until at East middle
part comes in cloudy with signs
of rain wind hauls but being
to at East heavy sail coming
up from at West last part
thick rainy weather & fresh breeze

Tuesday 7th

Come in with strong wind from
North with thick foggy weather
Ship heading East close hauled
the middle and latter part
continue the same

Come in with strong wind from
North & fine weather middle part
the wind hauls to N.W. West
heavy swell running from North
causing the ship to pitch like
a battering ram last part more
moderate & fine weather

Commences with strong breeze from
N.East with changeable weather
middle part clear away calm and
continues so through the day
one sail in sight to day
have sent down the main top sail
for repairs & sent up the old
one finished mending the sail
& stored it away ready for use

Come in with strong breeze from
N.East middle part freshens with
squalls of rain latter part wind
gays all round the compass light
baffling and plenty of rain at
seven A.M. clear up a little &
wind comes from at East again
