

Bark Sea Breeze bound from Honolulu

March 1891

Tuesday 21st

Comes in with good whol sail breeze from N.East and fair weather but up some of the head rigging to day latter part light squalls

Wednesday 22nd

Comes in with light wind from East N.East middle part hauls to S.East with fine weather throughout

Thursday 23rd

Comes in with light winds from S.E. and fine weather middle & latter part the same

Lat 25-54

Long 54-48

Friday 24th

Comes in with fine weather & light wind from S.East middle part the same latter part wind hauls to S.E.

Lat 27-34 N

Long 56-54 W

Saturday 25th

Comes in with light wind from the West & squally middle part wind hauls to N.West latter part baffling between N.W. & West

Lat 28-51

Long 58-04

Sunday 26th

Comes in with light baffling winds from the North middle & latter part calm and light breeze good weather throughout

March 1891

Monday 27th

Commences the first part calm at 8 A.M. light breeze from S.East hauls gradually round to W.S.W. with fresh breeze & good weather at ten P.M. look in S.E. Gall. Sails

Lat 29-38

Long 60-15

Tuesday 28th

Commences with strong wind from N.E. West steering N.W. & West under double reefed top Sails at 9 A.M. took a heavy squall from N.West that took all the wind away with it left us with calm & much rain weather looks very musty which I suppose is on account of our being in the vicinity of Bermuda the about one P.M. wind comes light from N.E. West & freshens gradually untill 5 P.M. it blows hard with threatening weather ship under double reef's & courses & set at 8 P.M. full mainsail & set continues to blow untill ten P.M. wind hauls to N.West & blows a Gale

Wednesday 29th

Commences blowing a Gale from N.West ship laying under close reefed main top Sail staysail & spruce clear & cool with some squalls at 3 P.M. wind moderates but does not haul any faster one Merchant Bark with 1 close reef's

Thursday 30th

Comes in with light wind from N.W. middle part calm and continues so throughout the day
