breeze and rain from North
Bk heading E. Galleet get on
Fire at 12 Pm saw a steamer
so ends the day

Thursday May 7th
Lat 36° 21'
Long 64° 34'
This day comes in squally North
shearing off South quarter rigged
saw fore steamer and 3 sails
latter part wind from the Westward
more moderate

Friday May 8th
Lat
Long
Light NW breeze with fine weather
shearing off S by W employed
getting ready for whaling so
ends this day under short sail

Saturday May 9th
Lat 35° 13'
Long 64° 34'
This day comes on with fine fresh
breeze from the Westward at 7 a.m.
made all sail heading by the wind
S by W bound to Newfoundland & S
for to get New Fore Topmast
Rigging so ends this day

Sunday May 10th
Lat 34° 02'
Long 64° 51'
Fore part of this day light air from
the Westward shearing S by W Middle
& latter part Calm Breeze from S
bearing South Dist 20 miles
