Days out 34 Monday June 1st Lat 45-10 N Long 51-57 W

Fore part of this day light breeze from N.W. under topsails heading R quite bugged, and one cast at 2 P.M. Tacked ship heading NE = Latter part fresh breeze steaming S.W. Wind S.S.E so ends the day

35 Tuesday June 2nd Lat 46-48 Long 51-31

This day comes in with quite fine weather from S.W. under all sail steaming NE by E & E saw 2 sails at 10 A.M. sighted a large Ice Barge & A.M. see another Ice Barge & Point of weather band started 5 lbs of Beef Water part lying aback

36 Wednesday June 3rd

This day comes in with light air and foggy from S.W. but day light fresh off steaming S by E 5 Ice Barges in sight from 3 to 5 P.M. sighted 4 more Ice Barges latter part calm with fog lying aback

Days out 37 Thursday June 4th Lat 48-45 N Long 48-50 W

Fore part of this day calm with thick fog middle & latter part fog lifted quite clear with light fair from N.W. steaming N.W. by E saw 2 Ice Barges and one schooner so ends this day

38 Friday June 5th Lat no observ Long

This day comes in with fog and calm middle & latter part light air from North steaming N.W. & weather clear latter part calm

39 Saturday June 6th Lat 49-32 Long 48-07

Fore part of this day light breeze and fine weather from N.W. steaming N.W. by E employed at various jobs so ends the day with a fine breeze from S.W.

40 Sunday June 7th Lat 51-20 Long

Fore part of this day fresh breeze from S.W. steaming N.W. by E some cloudy middle & latter part light air and calm from the westward so ends the day
