meat and left for shore at 10 pm

bearing N.W. compass fog quite
thick fog ends the day fast in the
fog

Tuesday July 28th

Fore part light air from S.E. working
off the N.W. 11 am wind light &
from N.W. fast in the fog
land about 20 miles off so ends
the day wind light from N.W. by
compass
