This day comes in with fine light
breezes from North at 5 P.M.
let go from the 2nd and worked out
to the Westward through the ice into
clear water at 10 A.M. in good working
water ice very scattering under all
sail on opposite tack some field ice
along on the North shore so ends
the day

Thursday July 30thOn
29th

This day comes in with fine weather
and light breezes from S.W. Steaming
by compass off by W some scattering ice
at 6 P.M. North Breeze bearing S.W. by S.
Labrador coast in sight so ends the
day

Friday July 31stOn
29th

This day comes in with fresh breezes
from S.W. at 2 A.M. came to field
ice left to heading to the Eastward
ice more open on the North shore
middle part under double reef top
sails with quite heavy rain Bk on
opposite tack, latter part thick
fog with light air some scattering ice
along the North shore at 10 A.M.

97

This day comes in with fresh
breezes from N.W. & clear
weather the North shore in sight
Dist 10 miles at 6 A.M. Steaming
W.S.W. along the field ice at
11:30 A.M. went through into
clear water to the N.W. at 10 P.M.
saw Charles Is bearing West
and saw the Bk. Lady Head
of London went on board
and left letters to be sent
home she made the ice of Resolute
July 31st at sun down Charles Is
bearing bearing about West Dist
20 miles so ends the day working
on West tack Labrador Coast in sight

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
