Dist 10 miles some scattering ice at 4 P.M. wind came out from N.W. with storm squally carried away the mainmast fell brook shot off at the flower band took in light sail and employed making a shoal on the mainmast the crew fore and aft at 6 P.M. set it up again so ends the day with light air & calm and heavy swell with rain & Fogg Bk heading N. the N.W.
