116 Fore part of this day light air from
 N. E. came to anchor in 10 fathoms
 of water off Whale Point S. B. yard
 in shore at 7:30 A.M. brought off
 some clams and 600 lbs of deer
 meat employed getting out water
 landed the clams at 2 P.M. and
 got under way at 2:30 P.M. with
 light air from S. W. steering off
 N. E. at 6 P.M. latter part heading
 to the S. E. aback Whaling Reef
 bearing N. W. saw smoke on shore

of New Bedford L. Fisher Master

119 This day comes in with a strong
 29 7/10 sail from S. E. made the
 west coast at 5 A.M. getting some
 halibut and at 7 A.M. kept off
 steering to the S. W. at 11 A.M.
 kept to under close reef on
 topsail heading off shore Cape
 Fullerton bearing N. W. Dist
 8 miles at 2 P.M. latter part heading
 to the eastward more more moderate
