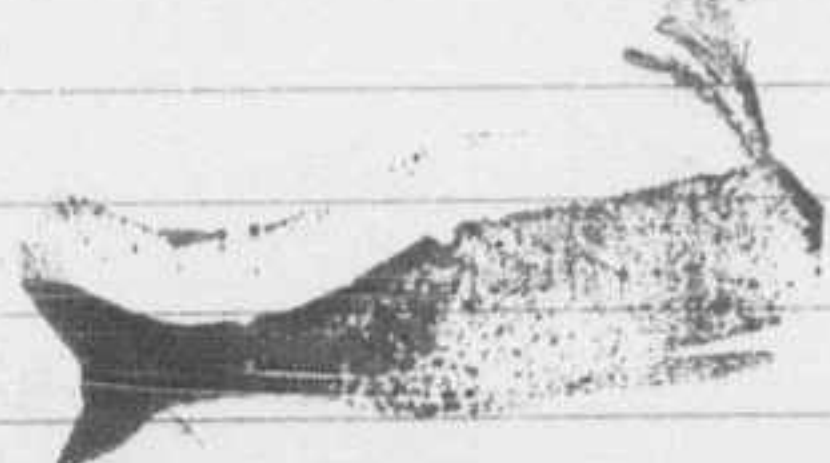


Remarks on board Bk A. R. Tucker

Days
out
from
Home 120
Wednesday Aug 26th Lat N
Long W
This day comes in with fine weather
from the Northward Cape Tullerton
in sight to the N.W. at 2 P.M.
2 boats from shore came on board
with natives. Latter part lying
aback heading off shore

Thursday Aug 27th
121
This day comes in with fine weather
from the Northward Land about
12 miles off the water left from
shore at 6 A.M. Bk heading to the
N.E. under all sail kept a New
Fore Top sail at 10 A.M. a boat came off
from shore and left at 4 P.M.
light on from N.E. Bk between Depot
Point & Cape Tullerton and 8 miles off
Latter part on opposite tack towards the
day kept a storm sparker

Friday Aug 28th
122
Light breezes from the N.E. Bk
on opposite tack Land in sight
Latter part Calm

Saturday Aug 29th Lat N
Long W
123
This part of this day Calm
Land in sight caught 2 seals
at 6 P.M. Cape Tullerton bearing
N.W. Dist 12 miles Latter part
light breezes from S.E.

Sunday Aug 30th
124
This day comes in with fresh
breezes from S.E. steering to the
N.E. at 6 A.M. passed Whale Point
and at 12 P.M. off Cape Haden
East shore weather some foggy
steering to the North of along
the East shore at 7 P.M. left
to go there heading W. & W. under
Double reef Top sails blowing
a moderate Gale from S.E. with
rain took in the Top sail and
the day

Monday Aug 31st
125
This day comes in with light
moderate winds from N.E. &
steering off S.W. quite foggy
saw the West Coast at 3 P.M.
about 6 miles off Bk steering W
at 6 P.M. heading off shore
lying aback blowing from N.E.
