Tuesday September 1st Lat Long N W

This day comes in with strong breeze from off Steaming off S.W. & West sighted the West Point at 4 a.m. Middle part fine moderate weather at 4 a.m. a Boat with Natives came on Board from Whale Point so ends the day lying off & on at Whale Point

Wednesday Sep 2nd

Br 29 3/4
127
Fine part light overthickly air off on Whale Point at 12 m. The Natives went on shore took a light breeze from S.W. standing off & on the land Whale Point bearing about N.W. Lying off & on

Thursday Sep 3rd

Br 29 3/4
128
Thursday had light fine weather from S.E. at 2.30 P.M. 3 Boats, 2 on board and left for shore at 6 P.M. Latter part off & on the land traded with the Natives about 110 lbs of Bone + 14 Musk Cow Skins and 2 Bear skins and a few Fox Skins about 5 took 4 Natives on board to go down to Marble Is.

This day comes in with fresh breeze from S.E. Whale Point bearing N.W. 10 miles middle part calm Latter part light breeze from S.E.

Saturday Sep 5th

This day comes in with strong breeze from the N.W. with cloudy weather and some rain & snow. At under Double reef Tapsails at 4 a.m. Whale Point bearing W.N.W. 10 miles at 12 m. commenced a moderate sail kept off the Steaming to the S.W. along the West shore under close reefed Tapsail. For Tapsail furled so ends the day heading off shore

Sunday Sep 6th

Fine part of this was moderate middle part light breeze under all sail wind from N.W. Cape Fullerton bearing N.E. Dist 10 mds at 6 P.M. Latter part Lying aback light N.W.W. winds
