Saturday Sep 12th Lat Long N W

This day comes in with light NW breeze. Land in sight at 10:30 am. Mr. Sampson saw a Bass Head forced to + NW and returned on board at 3 pm. no change at 6 pm. South Head land of Chatterfield Point bearing S.W. Dist 12 miles. Latter part came in squally with rain & snow from S.W. heading off shore at sun down and a gale (supposed to be the same) in off weather but no change to lower.

Sunday Sep 13th

13th Br 29 7/10

Five part of this day strong breeze and squally from NW or NW by N. heading off shore at 10 am under all sail. Land at 12:30 am. saw the land off Depot. Is took ship. N. steering to the SW at 6 am. St. Johns bearing W.S.W. Dist 5 miles. so fresh the day with light air from the westward flying off the land in 12 fathoms 1/2 of water on the day.

Monday Sep 14th Lat Long N W

This day comes in with light breeze from S.W. with light fog & rain saw the land at 7 a.m. of South Head of Chatterfield Point at 3 pm. calm with thick fog and at 6 pm took a strong breeze from S.W. hark heading to the Eastward blowing a moderate gale from S.W.

Tuesday Sep 15th

140 Br 29 7/10

This day comes in more moderate from S.W. standing in there at 5:30 a.m. keep off steering S.W. by S under Double reefed Top sails at 8 am sighted Marble Pt. and at 1:30 pm. came to anchor in 7 fathoms of water off Deadman Pt. so ends the day more moderate.

Wednesday Sep 16th

141 Br 29 7/10

This day comes in with light pleasant weather from NW at 5 am got under way on under all sail heading to the Eastward & Northward at sun down left off the Mont Jones bearing NW. Land about 3 miles off wind light from the NW.
