This day had flying birds from 4 a.m. lying at anchor SB went on shore weather some overcast rather faint light

Saturday Sep 19th

144

This day comes in with moderate weather from SE at 6 a.m. took anchor and dropped in side between Marble IS + Dead man's IS dropped both anchors got out water and put 4 casks on Dead man's IS sent down 4 main top gallant sails at 4 p.m. having a fair breeze so ends the day with show & rain

This day comes in with a heavy gail from SE with rain at 8 a.m. ship heeled 1/2 madder run a cage anchor and at 12.30 m. made fast and got per. off and anchored in fine light at 6 p.m. 27.8 N so ends the day both anchors down

Monday Sep 21st

This day comes in with fresh breeze from SE middle part, called to W.S.W. started 4 casks of coal one cask of molasses so ends the day

Tuesday Sep 22nd

147

Light pleasant weather from S.S.E. employed landed on Dead man's IS left W.B. + gear and 18 casks and spain boats mast + etc. latter put thick fog from SE
