dropped and hauled the ship
ahead moderate breeze from S.E.

This day comes in with a
bail from N.W. both anchors
+ cage down + Br at 4 a.m.
28th starting up at 5 a.m.
at 12 m Br 29th blowing strong
at intervals at 2 p.m. went up ship
and got 2 tubs of lines from shore
Latter part strong breezes

Friday Sep 25th
150

This day comes in with
fresh breeze from N.W. with
cloudy weather at 12 m
took a light breeze from
S.E. & took up the Starboard
anchorage it being foul with
the Port chain at 3 p.m.
commenced to snow at 11 p.m.
called all hands to heave
ahead on the chains ship being
in 2 fathoms at or end the day

Saturday Sep 26th Lat N

This day comes in with fresh
breezes from S.E. and our cast
at 8 a.m. put the cage down
and hauled off from Dead man
Is and dropped both anchors
45 fathoms of cable out
commenced to haul a bail
from S.W. at 2 p.m. Br
falling at 6 p.m. on 29th
Latter part blowing a heavy bail
from S.W. with snow hail & rain
both anchors & cage down

Sunday Sep 27th
152

This day comes in about the same
at 3 a.m. Br 28th and at 4
a.m. more moderate with rain
wind veer to the N.W. at 8 a.m.
took a heavy bail from N.W. with
some small squalls at 10 a.m. Br 28th
at 12 m heavy squalls East end of
Dead man Is about 30 yards off Br at
12 m 28th at 3 p.m. 29th still
blowing a heavy bail at 6 p.m.
weather some more broken with
ant snow and quite cold
Latter part blowing heavy by squalls
