160 This day comes in with strong breeze from S.W. at 10 A.M. blowing a fair breeze S.W. at sun down more moderate so ends the day

161 Tuesday Oct 6th
This day comes in calm here up the anchors and cleared them at 2 P.M. took a light breeze from N.E. Thru 34 so ends the day

Wednesday Oct 7th

162 Light breeze from N.E. Cleared the anchors employed about the house latter part the same

Thursday Oct 8th

163 This day comes in with a fresh gail from S.W. with rain & snow at sun down more moderate wind halled to S.W. latter part blowing a gail from N.W.

Friday Oct 9th Thru 2 a

164 This day comes in with a moderate gail from N.W. and quite cold latter part more moderate

Saturday Oct 10th

165 This day had fresh breeze from the westward set up the stone in the house on deck so ends the day

Sunday Oct 11th Thru 24 a

166 Light breeze from N.E. employed clearing the anchors & cage so ends this day

Monday Oct 12th Thru 21 a

167 Light N.E. breeze, all hands employed on shore cutting ice. Carpenter worked at 4:30 P.M. and cleared the anchors so ends this day

Tuesday Oct 13th Thru 20 a

168 Light air and cloudy here North finished cutting ice at 12 M so ends the day light air
