Day Friday Oct 23rd To 8 B-2
 From 178

This day had light NW
 winds cleared the anchors
 run from ice at 7 PM
 ice anchors down Port out
 latter part moderate

Saturday Oct 24th To 10 A-2

179 This day comes in with light
 breeze from South with snow
 falling ice holding the ship
 got out water latter part light
 breeze from the South drifted
 the Schooner anchor at 8 PM

Sunday Oct 25th

180 To 4 B-2

Br 30⁰⁰ Ice part of this day strong
 breeze from S. of ice hole up
 at 6 PM wind moderate from
 North clear water so ends the day

Monday Oct 26th To 4 B-2

181 Light North winds with
 snow took up the Schooner
 anchor at midnight light ice
 about the ship some small pieces
 of ice ended the day drifted the
 Schooner anchor at 11 AM ice
 broken up light breeze from NW

Tuesday Oct 27th To 5 B-2

182 Light pleasant weather from
 NW quite cold so ends the
 day

Wednesday Oct 28th To 10 B-2

183 Light breeze from NW young
 ice round the ship so ends the
 day

Thursday Oct 29th To 10 B-2

144 Light breeze from NW ice
 up to the anchors through
 the ice ice 4 inches thick
 so ends the day moderate

Friday Oct 30th To 18 B-2

185 Light breeze from NW ice
 up both anchors on the main
 the house and figured building
 so ends the day

Saturday Oct 31st To 10 B-2

186 Light North winds latter
 part snow

Sunday Nov 1st To 12 B-2

187 Strong North winds
 so ends the day
