Saturday Nov 28th
 Br 29 $\frac{7}{10}$ 214 This day moderate from N.W.
 got 2 floods of ice & employed
 Bankery ship so ends

Sunday Nov 29th Tr 6 BZ
 Br 29 $\frac{7}{10}$ 215 This day comes in with a moderate
 gale from S.W. at 2 P.M. 6
 men went over to the ice pond at
 6 P.M. blowing a heavy gale from
 West 2 natives went in search of
 the men but returned with out seeing
 or hearing from them at 7 P.M.
 one by the name of J. J. came
 along having left the other 5 &
 took another route the 2 natives
 started out in search of them at
 7:20 P.M. Br at 8 P.M. 28 $\frac{7}{10}$ Natives came
 back at 8:30 with out success blowing
 a severe gale from West and ended
 blowing in drifts this day got out
 the same 50 rings of the men
