Days
from
Home

Monday Nov 30th To 34 N 2

This day comes in about the same
Pr going up at 5 Am 29th no one
of the 5 men have shown up yet
at 8 Am To 34 N 2 the 2 natives
and one man for that left them last
night started for at 8 a.m. in search
of the 5 men wind about W. N. W. at
9 a.m. one of the men came by the
claw of Harvard the natives found
2 men in a poor state but they
got to the ship all right at 9 a.m.
The mate started with a bang of
a sled for one helps one make
started for the ship about the
poor man being hurt so bad that
he did not get on board at 10:30 a.m.
The natives still in search for one
man by the name of Prisoner they
found him at the last end of
Marble about 400 yds they got
him to the ship at 4 P.M.
with both feet and hands frozen
hard as a rock commencing to
suck them in ice water got the
dead man into the box and out
on the sled so ends the day may
mediate from W. N. W. rocking the
man's feet & hands in ice water

Tuesday Dec 1st

217
Pr 29:00 This day comes in with a heavy
faint from N. E. & thick the 2 dead
bodies lying along side of ship
at 6 P.M. took the frozen man
feet & hands out of water and
put them into cold bottles so
ends

Wednesday Dec 2nd To 10 N 2

218
Pr 29:00 This day light N. E. winds and
cloudy foggy the 2 men on dead
ground N. E. and at 2 P.M. heard
the men that were to die on the
30th Nov William Crosby so ends
wind from W. N. W.

Thursday Dec 3rd To 34 N 2

Pr 29:00 Strong breezes from W. N. W. so
ends the day

Friday Dec 4th

220
Pr 29:00 Light pleasant weather from
N. E. employed Bunking ship
so ends

221 Saturday Dec 5th To 52 N 2
Pr 29:00 blowing a strong breeze from
North cloudy so ends
