Days from Home 352  
Thursday April 14<sup>th</sup> T 32 BZ  
Light pleasant weather from NW so ends

Friday April 15<sup>th</sup> T 28 BZ  
Light breeze from the Northward get 99 casks from deadman's st. on the ship so ends

Saturday April 16<sup>th</sup> T 22 BZ  
Strong breeze from the Northward and pleasant put the slide boards on to the ship so ends more moderate

Sunday April 17<sup>th</sup> T 20 BZ  
Fresh breeze from the North and pleasant so ends

Monday April 18<sup>th</sup> T 10 B & S. ds  
Light pleasant weather from SW employed breaking out the T casks and sprung it for in water sprung 10 casks of coal also run down the cables off deck out of the way so ends

Tuesday April 19<sup>th</sup> T 10-15 BZ  
Light pleasant weather from SW commenced to break out the after Hale and set a dead from Bump Port side so ends

Wednesday April 20<sup>th</sup> T 5-20 BZ  
Light variable winds and cloudy employed lugging casks and started the grapple for salt water in after Hale latter part blowing a gail from NW

Thursday April 21<sup>st</sup> T 40 BZ  
This day blowing a gail from NW and cold so ends

Friday April 22<sup>nd</sup> T 30 BZ  
Fore part of this day blowing a gail from NW latter part quite moderate so ends

Saturday April 23<sup>rd</sup> T 10-28 BZ  
Light North winds got one load of ice cleared up the main deck from snaw so ends
