Days from Arrive 362 Sunday April 24th T 10 x 20 BZ
 This day comes in calm and pleasant Breeze & latter part fresh breeze from Southward

Ar 363 Monday April 25th T 20 x 25 BZ
 Light N.W. winds & pleasant employed halving ice from the Southward to trap sheet at the head of the inner harbor 146 Cakes took on board 12 Cakes so ends the day

Ar 364 Tuesday April 26th T 28 x 40 BZ
 This day strong Northerly winds & cloudy with some snow latter part fresh Gail from the Southward

Ar 365 Wednesday April 27th T 28 x 40 BZ
 Fresh breeze from N.W. some cloudy and quiet cold so ends

Ar 366 Thursday April 28th T 28 x 35 BZ
 Light N.W. winds & pleasant but cold so ends

Ar 367 Friday April 29th T 20 x 35 BZ
 Fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant and cold shifted the latter so ends

Ar 368 Saturday April 30th T 0 - 35 BZ
 Fore part light pleasant weather from the North got one load of ice latter part blumping a fresh Gail from the Southward

Ar 369 Sunday May 1st T 0 - 24 BZ
 Fore part of the day light westerly winds turned the breeze over at Dead man's Bay latter part fresh breeze from the Southward

Ar 370 Monday May 2nd T 10 x 20 BZ
 Light and fresh breeze from the Southward making a new sail for the so ends clear and the snow from the mountains

Ar 371 Tuesday May 3rd T 10 x 20 BZ
 Fresh breeze from the South with snow latter part fine weather

Ar 372 Wednesday May 4th T 15 BZ
 Fresh breeze from S.W. employed in the whale steaming salt water in the ground in latter half and fore part steamed 78 BZ so ends this day
