 W & N and some cloudy get
 started for the land and got
 ready and commenced to sail
 so ends get off 9 fish pieces

Tuesday May 17th T 10-34 BZ

Light pleasant weather from
 W & N employed sailing
 out got off 8 fish pieces so
 ends

Wednesday May 18th T 32 BZ

This day comes in with
 strong easterly winds
 employed sailing out at
 11 AM commenced to snow
 got out 5 fish pieces, went down
 and packed up the tools Bailing
 a heavy sail from East so ends

 W & N started for a cask of Read 821
 lbs. Later part was moderate

Saturday May 21st T 5-26 BZ

389

This day had light pleasant
 weather from W & N employed
 sailing. Ice got out 11 fish pieces
 240 feet so ends

Sunday May 22nd T 10-24 BZ

This day had fresh hakes from
 S. The relatives came back with
 13 deer & one wolf employed
 sailing. Ice got out 10 fish pieces
 worked about 7 hours. Ice jammed
 at low water so ends
