True part of this day light  
air from N.W. the pack  
still in could not get off and  
on the Island took down the  
Decks House and used the

nothing so ends

Friday June 3<sup>rd</sup> T 20-30032  
This day comes in with moderate  
weather from E the pack went  
out up to the main flow middle  
part came in with strong breeze  
from N.W. Latter part blowing Ice  
bail with some hail so ends

29 3/4  
Saturday June 4<sup>th</sup> T 30-35  
True part of this day blowing a  
heavy gale from N.W. got off  
Decks gut 13 head of ship and  
2 Starboard quarters Latter part  
fine weather from N.W. with  
moderate breeze Ice all clear from  
the main Island so ends Cut out  
14 ft. Decks
