from S.E. and foggy. Pack of ice
in the Harbor of latter part
cleared off so ends

Monday June 13th

This day comes in with fresh
breeze from S.S.W. & S.E. the
ice still in can not get out. Latter part
pleasant so ends

For part of this day light & E
winds & foggy. Latter part light
from drift ice & pleasant. The
Pack still in so ends mended
the Galt Topsail

Wednesday June 15th

This day Light breeze from
N.W. at 10-30 A.M. ~~the~~ took
the ship out in outer Harbor
walked her out with lines with
the men on each side made
back to the main plan at 6-30
A.M. Ice in from the end of plan
& made 25 lots of ice out side
so ends

Thursday June 16th

This day comes in moderate
from the northward the Pack
about 15 miles off employed
get all the packs and latter
stuff on board put the
old Boat on the House and
all 3 Boats on the crains rose
the cutting falls and now
all ready for sea at sun down
strong breeze from the westward
the Pack 15 miles off
