This day moderate breeze from WSW & NW, went down to the East end of Marble Is in 11 B for the ice in from the East end as far as the ice could reach so the main channel so ends cant get out

Saturday June 18th

This day had light baffin winds & pleasant lots of ice off the East end no chance of getting out so ends Thursday

Sunday June 19th

29⁷/₁₀

418

This day had strong breeze from NE to E with fog & cloudy. Could not see over one mile off so ends

Monday June 20th

29⁷/₁₀

419

For part of this day strong breeze from off the North with thick fog. Latter part clear with strong NW winds some ice to the Eastward so ends

Tuesday June 21st

420

This day fine pleasant weather but blowing a strong breeze from NE, the Capt. went for the East end and found it all packed in to the ice so no chance of getting out so ends

Wednesday June 22nd

For part of this day light breeze from off the L & N.B. went to the East end saw nothing but ice from S.W. to S. & got N.W. as far as the ice could reach returned on board at 11:30 am and and painted the L & N.B. so ends calm

Thursday June 23rd

This day light air from SE to S.W. & pleasant employed setting up the Head gear. The ice land in packed up to the Flare no passage to get out not with a boat so ends

Friday June 24th

This day came in with light air from S.E. & middle & latter light from W & N. Ice started out some so ends
