From Home 424
 This day comes in with light breezes from S.E. & some S. started out no chance of getting out so ends with Fogg

Sunday June 25th

425
 This day comes in with cloudy weather with a fresh breeze from S.E. to S. the barometer dropped with ice all round the ship sundown light air from S.W. to W.S.W. Latter part Blowing a gale from S.E.

Monday June 27th

426
 Fore part of this day Blowing a gale from S.E. & at 4 P.M. the ice started off middle part some rain and snow at 7 P.M. no ice in sight from Starboard wind blowing about the same but from N.W. with light driften rain so ends

Tuesday June 28th

427
 This day some clouds with a strong breeze from N.W. & S.W. some ice into the ice of Marble Is looking favorable to get out tomorrow

Wednesday June 28th
 428

Fore part of this day cloudy with light driften rain with strong breeze from moderate gale from S.W. lots of ice into the ice no chance of getting out later got 2 seals so ends

Thursday June 30th

429
 Fore part of this day strong breeze from N.W. to driften middle to latter part light air from N.W. with light rain & Fogg no chance of getting out so ends

Friday July 1st

430
 Fore part of this day light N.E. breeze & pleasant middle & latter part light baffin air & calm lots of ice no chance to get out 2 natives came from Thain land and reported seeing a cow & calf off Rabbit Is for 5 days

Saturday July 2nd

431
 This day light baffin air & calms and pleasant started for Rabbit Is L. & W.B. to look for whales but returned could not get them in account of ice the harbor full of ice no chance of making so ends
