Sunday July 3rd

This day had light air from South. Started off with 200 B & 90 B but returned on board at 11 A.M. on account of the ice too far as the ship can reach all around the ice as 2 natives came over from the coast in kay & 20 birds.

29 3/10

Monday July 4th

29 3/10

This day fresh breeze from the southward ice and air to the ship no open water so cloudy so ends

29 7/10

Tuesday July 5th

434

29 7/10

Light breeze from S. & S.W. and very warm. Ice still in no chance of getting out. The 2 natives went back for the rest so ends

29 5/10

Wednesday July 6th

435

29 5/10

For part of this day blowing a gale with 15 mph and rain from S. & S.W. with latter part clear with light breeze from S. & S.W. plenty of ice off the harbor so ends so ends

Thursday July 7th

29 2/10

For part of this day light breeze from the southward, middle part came in fresh breeze from the westward and pleasant at 7 P.M. the spread out some things, looking favorable to get out to morning. One of the natives saw a whale just out side of the harbor to the westward about 8 miles in the strait so ends

29 4/10

Friday July 8th

437

29 4/10

Sailed

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This day comes in with light breeze from NW and pleasant at 2:30 A.M. let go from the ice and made to get down of the ice and took the ice went into the ice with light breeze and middle part thick fog and the ship lost to the ice all the natives & 2 dogs on board so ends

29 6/10

Saturday July 9th

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For part of this day light NW wind with thick fog & ship fast to the ice at 6 A.M. cleared off at 4 P.M. the ice open made all sail light breeze from the SW and worked out to the ice at 7:30 got out of the bay & made working on shore so ends
