Day  
 Home 446  
 On 29 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 Sunday July 17<sup>th</sup>  
 Fore part of this day thick fog with light air + calm from N. lying to in quarters. Ice at 4 P.M. Fog lifted. Ice quite scattered out to the edge of the ship in tow with S.B. ahead working to the edge at 11 P.M. came thick fog fast to close

Monday July 18<sup>th</sup>

On 447  
 On 27 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 This day comes in with light air from N.W. with fog at intervals at 7 A.M. quite clear with ice open some let go from the ice working to the edge at 5 P.M. wind strong from W.S.W. got up to the solid pack and took in all sail and made fast to the ice so ends with a fresh sail from N.W. S.W.

Tuesday July 19<sup>th</sup>

On 448  
 On 29 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 Fore part of this day fresh sail from S.W. + cloudy with thick ice all around ship fast to the ice shore in ground in Port Hole 48 Bld of salt water so ends fog

Wednesday July 20<sup>th</sup>

On 449  
 On 29 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 This 24 hours light air + calm from N.W. with thick fog ship fast to the ice also ship surrounded by ice at 6 P.M. Fog lifted a little with light air and calm from the S.E. let go from the ice and made all sail with S.B. ahead working to the edge so ends

Thursday July 21<sup>st</sup>

On 450  
 On 29 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 Light air from about E with thick fog lying ahead at 7 A.M. Told up the ice at 1 P.M. let go again with light air from the northeast and at 4 P.M. made fast again ice very thick nearly calm but quite clear + pleasant so ends

Friday July 22<sup>nd</sup>

On 451  
 On 27 $\frac{5}{10}$   
 Fore part of this day light breeze from N.W. but 7 P.M. let go from the ice working to the edge ice quite fresh + pleasant ice quite thick and steps of water over the packed ice to the N.W. Marked Bread + Cook at 9:30 P.M. made fast to the ice so ends the day with thick fog light breeze from S.W.
