Saturday July 23rd

452 This day comes in with light
a light breeze from S.W. and Fogg
at 4 AM fog lifted got under
way at 7 AM working through
thick ice to the N.W. part
ice very thick middle & latter part
more open with fresh breeze from S
lying on opposite tack so ends

29th Sunday July 24th Lat 63:20 N

453 This day light & fresh breeze
from S.W. lying in a hole
of water & working off on opposite
tack, saw quite a strip of water
into the N. so ends

454 This day comes in quite pleasant
with fresh breeze from S.W. lots of
ice at 7 AM ship off and worked
through the open ice to the S.W. into
open water get through the ice at 1:30
AM steering to the S.W. in clear sky
ice came N.W. so ends working
through strips of ice more to the
Westward saw the land but junc
bearing NW to N.W. 30 miles off
so ends

Tuesday July 26th

455 This day comes in with light
pleasant weather from the Southward
at 10 AM from the shore to S and 10
miles of there shore ice all gone at 7:30
AM L. & W.B. landed 6 stations on
the main in of Mount Jones & are
hunting and the 2 Bears worked
the coast up in shore to the Fairway
20 off mouth of Chester field inlet
returned as heard at 6:20 PM
saw nothing at 4 PM took a light
breeze from N.W. S.W. sent a boat
and got 3 of the stations on board
so ends by 10 PM Mount Jones 3 to
4 miles of light air breeze N.W. S.W.

Wednesday July 27th

456 Fresh breeze from the Southward
got off the other 3 stations got 10 Bears
fresh off leaving at 9 AM as well
as the 2 Bears worked perfectly some
heavy ships to the Southward plenty
of water into the coast at 6 PM
breeze head land to Chester field
inlet hearing N.W. Dist 12 miles
at 10 AM flew back so ends
