Thursday July 28<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with light  
easterly winds off on opposite  
side / working to the north  
very little scattering I see saw  
the main land off shore Dept  
Is at 7 am hearing a m saw  
lots of Walrus on the ice latter part  
light breeze from NE to E working North  
som hazy

Friday July 29<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with fresh  
breeze from north working up the  
Coast some hazy, lots of ice into  
the sea to NNE and in 1/2 m  
middle + latter part strong breeze  
from NE working up to Wharf Point  
at 6 PM it hearing a m all hazy  
mky fog & rain at 10 m sails  
latter part came in thick with  
rain blowing a gale from NE  
on opposite / talks some scattering  
ice

Saturday July 30<sup>th</sup>

This day blowing  
a fresh gale from NE under  
double reefed topsails with thick  
rainy weather & at 8 PM more  
moderate and clear made sail with  
some scattering ice and the main  
sail from 7 to 10 PM saw the  
land King Herman hearing about  
1/2 Dist 18 m point 14 miles -  
left Fullerton hearing 1/2 m Fagg  
lifted at intervals at 10 m which  
the point 2 boats come from shore  
and took about all of the walrus  
on shore latter part fresh breeze  
and hazy flying off and on  
wind at 1/2

29 4/5

Sunday July 31<sup>st</sup>

This day comes in with fresh  
breeze from NE with hazy weather  
2 boats came off and took the  
remainder of the walrus made  
sail bound for the east shore &  
walrus on board at 2 PM. Talked  
ship on account of ice could not  
get to the east shore at 3 PM  
J B went on shore at Wharf Point  
at 9 PM 2 shore boats brought a small  
whale blubber and bone 4 feet long whale  
taken last June so ends with  
moderate weather
