

Remarks on board Bk A. B. Fisher

Monday August 1st

29th

Few part of this day light
N. breeze with fog lifting &
clearing at 1 P.M. cleared up
at 5 P.M. coming down from
about 2 miles off Yellow Bluff
to the SE and along shore
at 7 P.M. SB went on shore and
got 3 natives father part morning
the handicapped on opposite tack through
scattering ice bound to Neptune Bay
strong breeze from NW

Tuesday Aug 2nd

29th

This day comes in with strong
breeze from NW with some fog
working through ice towards
land at 10 P.M. blowing a Gail
from NW and on at Yellow
Bluff between the land & ice strip
of water about 3 miles wide under
double raft top sails girt & sparke
at 1 P.M. went out into new water through
scattering ice to ends of day lying
on opposite tack with a heavy Gail
from NW and some fog and
very rough water

Wednesday August 3rd

29th

This day comes in with a Gail
from NW very heavy sea running
some scattering ice off under
close reef top sails. Visible from
1 to 4 miles on opposite tack
saw Yellow Bluff at 2 P.M.
came in thick with rain to
ends

Thursday Aug 4th

29th

This day comes in with a Gail
of wind from NW with thick
fog under short sail on opposite
tacks very rough some scattering
ice at 10 P.M. moderated and
at 11 P.M. fog lifted a few minutes
saw the land of Bk supposed to be
off Whale Point. Latter part
very light breeze from NW with
light fog made some sail so
close on opposite tack foggy

Friday Aug 5th

10th ET

29th

Few part of this day light air &
calms with fog lying off the land
in 20 fathoms off water the 3 natives
took the crew head Boat and started
for shore at 3 P.M. took light air from
SW but thick fog lying about 20 ends
