

Remarks on board Bk A. B. Tucker

Day's
Home 466
Saturday August 6th

29th Fine part of this day light breeze from N.E. going ahead into thick fog. Started the works and holed out the blubber making about 800 blubber finished and got it. Started down at 3:30 P.M. Fog lifted at 2 P.M. saw the land off Cape Fullerton at 4 P.M. Raine in strong breeze with thick fog from N.E. standing off shore land in sounds.

Sunday Aug 7th

29th 467 This day comes in with fresh breeze from N.E. with fog on off shore. Started at 10 A.M. Fog lifted and at 7 P.M. S.B. went off. There came at 8 A.M. latter part heading to the Eastward under short sail sounds.

Monday Aug 8th

29th 468 Fine part of this day light pleasant weather from N.E. at 4 P.M. Whale Point 10 miles off Bk. day the wind heading to the Eastward at 10 A.M. sighted the E. shore at 3 P.M. took a haul from N.W. Point Garden leaving E. shore. Out 10 miles at 4 P.M. in ends Bk. heading N.W.

Tuesday August 9th

29th 467 Fine part of this day came in squally with strong breeze from N.W. under short sail heading to the N.W. at 2 A.M. made the West shore about 15 miles North of Yellow Bluff kept off shoring along shore at 3:30 P.M. started and kept right on shore at Whale Point latter part flying off shore.

Wednesday Aug 10th

29th 470 Light breeze from N.W. off Whale Point quite pleasant at 2 P.M. 2 Boats came off from shore and brought some Deer meat at 4 P.M. they left for shore with light breeze from N.W. kept a fair main sail at 4 P.M. kept off shoring to the North along shore. At 5:30 Day better rose a l. Whale lived 2 Boats at 5:45 L.B. started and N.B. & S.B. took the Whale along side about 7 P.M. also 2 Boats came from shore, got ready and commenced cutting finished at 11:30 P.M. Bk. heading off shore wind from S.W. sounds.
