This day came in with strong breeze from SE the sea was choppy. Boats went on shore at 7 o'clock. Bk under port sail on opposite tacks. Middle left strong breeze from South with smooth weather off Yellow Bluff so good with a moderate breeze from South very breezy.

This day comes in with a gale from NW kept off running down the coast till the SW some breeze visible about 1 mile at 3 PM. Light off shore under short sail 25 miles south of Cape Foulweather and started to Boil at 2 PM Bk heading off shore about S.S.E at 10 PM the breeze abate some foggy so ends with moderate breeze.

Fore part of this day light breeze from about SE at 15 am. Work ship standing in shore. Visible about 3 to 4 miles. Employed Boiling at 8:30 Thick Foggy so ended and got to Faggy. Bk of make was ship heading to the NW and got to Faggy. Called all hands and dropped anchor and took in sail, dropped both anchor and stock out 60 fathoms off port. Let up at 4 PM so as to see the land. Bk heading NW Dist 7 miles saw breakers thick Foggy at inter. Vails wind quite light at 7 PM. Wind came out from West and blowing to breeze on the NW and on the S. Board anchor and at 9 PM called all hands and got under way so ends Bk under close reefed sails heading to the Southward. Breeze a gale from west also started down the air when we finished boiling at 9 am. Stowed S.S. S.
