Sunday August 14th
This day comes in with a
Gail from N.W. held in F. S. and
Bk heading to the S.W. at 6 am
more moderate wind sail and at
12. m. spool all sail Mont Jones
in sight at 12.30 am sighted
Mankle Is. Bound into Grashly
Is. for water got out the Cask
ready to raft at 5.0 am rounded
the other end working up to the
Harker wind about N.W. at 9 am
called all hands and at 9.30 came
the anchor out side of Dead man's
Is. in 7 Fathoms of water got
the raft over board and took it
on shore and filed the so ends

Monday Aug 15th

This day comes in with
fine pleasant weather from N.W.
got the raft of water off at 9.30
am 60 lbs and at 8 am took
the anchor on the land latter part
hearing to the S.W. at 7.0 am
Mont Jones bearing S.W. Dist
20 miles and with strong breeze
sailing at 1/2 by 1/2

For part of this day fresh breeze
from N.W. and hazy sailing
at 4.0 am sighted the
land and at 5.0 am took a
strong breeze from N.W. the
spring heading off from
the land Cape Foxworth 10
miles off at 11.0 am saw
a Bull Head 4 miles S.E. of what
point land but did not see
him again returned on board at
2.0 am at 7.0 am rose 2 more and
saw the Beasts 7 miles S.E. of what
point 2 miles off shore returned on
board at 9.30 am the wind second

Wednesday Aug 17th

This day comes in with strong
breeze from S. with cloudy weather
cleared off at 8 am sighted a
whale about 6 miles off what point
land the Beasts were very light
whale lost into the shore the B.
A. came Beasts came and called
the whale returned on board
at 4.0 am wind light from N.W.
at 8.0 am a whale about 5 miles
off the land the Beasts and returned
the heard at 9.30 with a success
so ends by on off with sails up
