This day comes in moderate from N.W. Bk off & on in the afternoon between W. Point & Yellow Bluff at 10 AM commenced with strong breeze from N.W. Bk off Yellow Bluff dusk with topsails standing off & on Yellow Bluff at 5 PM Breeze a Gail took the Boats up and left with topsails & happy so ends standing off shore of heading 32

Friday Aug 19th

On 475
29th This day comes in with light air from S.W. & thick Fog at 7 AM took a breeze from N.W. Bk heading to the N at 9 AM a moderate Gail as some clearance made the land of Yellow Bluff and at 12 AM strong ship from the land strong breeze under topsails with topsails and bottom stay sails so ends the day off and for Yellow Bluff

Saturday Aug 20th

On 480
29th This day comes in with fine light breeze from N.W. Bk led the boats at 10 AM and went in shore between Yellow Bluff & Whale Point. Saw nothing but a fresh breeze from S.W. at 4 AM saw 2 whales headed at 4:30 AM. W.B. took the whale sun about 5 miles into the Starboard took the whale along side at 8 PM and commenced to cut came in thick Fog & rainy wind quite light got both lips & throat in and started cutting the ends

Sunday Aug 21st

On 481
29th This day comes in with thick Fog and rain started cutting at 2 AM to wait for day light at 9 AM commenced again finished at 10:30 and cleared away the head wind from N.W. and quite clear say the land started the whales at 10 PM so ends
