

Remarks on board Rk A. B. Tucker

Day
from
Home 500
Friday September 9th Lat 63-51
Fore part of this day strong
breeze from S.W. and some
foggy visible about 2 or 3 miles
at 9 am rose a whale sized
W.B. streak took the whale along
side at 1 P.M. saw no land
but supposed the ship to be about
10 miles S.W. of Cape Fullerton got
up Fastenings of water commenced
the cut at 2 P.M. very rough
at 2:30 P.M. came off this fog
nearly rain finished cutting
at 10:30 P.M. were ship
hugging to the S.W. under
clubby soft topsails shows of rain
so ends

Saturday Sep 10th Lat 63-59
501
29th This day comes in with Fog
and light rain shows from S.W.
Clear away the fog at 6 am
middle part some foggy with
light air from S.W. Steaming
N.W. started the works at 3 P.M.
later part calm lying ahead

Sunday Sep 11th
502
29th Fore part of this day fresh breeze
from N.E. sighted the land
off Cape Fullerton weather
cloudy and some foggy at 8
Am one Boat came off from
shore commenced heaving in
Boat left for shore at 11:30 Am
at 12 M took in Fore Topsail
at 2 P.M. coiled down the works
blowing a Gail from N.E. made
the land off Cape Fullerton
about 2 miles off Foggy were
ship heading to the Eastward
saw rain to hail blowing a
Gail now to under main
Topsail so ends
