at 3 PM wind hauled to S.W. at
4 PM sighted the Digges Is and
Regist. off Starboard. Bk
steaming S.W. by E. Cabot in heavy
snow storm at 4.30 PM hauled
up light sails latter part blowing a
breeze and clear sail on off light

a heavy sail from N.W. Bk under
main topsail double reef & main stay
sail fore top sail in Bk heading N.W.
heavy rain on with snow squalls
at day light wind shift and 5 PM
rose Digges Is 15 miles S.W.
Bk heading N.W. set fore topsail
& fore sail and fog at 7.30 AM
rose Northernham Is 3 points of weather
Bk heading E by N. compass
wind blowing a fair breeze ahead of
true quite clear. Middle part under
all sail steering S.W. at 2 PM
came in with heavy snow squalls
and thick at intervals took in some
sail. Paid scuttling for all day
by patches hauled overboard in sight
at 7 PM hauled in under short sail
heading to the S.W. more moderate
